Parent(s)/guardians are an important part of the Driver Training process and must attend the first night of the driver training class. Students must have their Oregon permit before class starts. A certificate is issued upon successful (80% or better) completion of the class that can be taken to DMV and the Drive test will be waived. Class fee includes books.
